# **TOGAF** Certification for People


- Ensures that individuals are knowledgeable about TOGAF




- Individuals requiring a deeper understanding of TOGAF 9;

- Architects who want to achieve a recognized qualification to demonstrate their detailed knowledge of TOGAF 9.




